The district will provide any information available to aid in the identification of any areas of concern for conditions, which cannot be readily observed by standard assessment procedures throughout the districts facilities and the district acknowledges that the scope of services provided by the professional authoring the Facilities Assessment Report does not include invasive facilities and grounds investigation; and
