Adoption of Pickup for Teachers

Be it resolved, effective September 1, 2006, the Celina City Board of Education agrees to "pick up" the total amount of employee contributions required by Section 3307.26 of the Ohio Revised Code to be contributed by the teachers to STRS Ohio. The Celina City Board of Education is permitted to pick up employee contributions pursuant to Sections 3307.27 of the Ohio revised code and Section 414(h)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code. These picked up contributions, although designated as employee contributions, are being paid by the Celina City Board of Education in lieu of employee contributions and shall be treated as a mandatory salary reduction from the contract salary otherwise payable to the employee.

Employees in this group may not opt-out of the "picked up" contributions or elect to receive the contributed amounts directly instead of having them picked up by the Celina City Board of Education and paid to STRS Ohio.

Adoption of Pickup fro Superintendent and Administrators

Be it resolved, effective August 1, 2006, the Celina City Board of Education agrees to "pick up" the total amount of employee contributions required by Section 3307.26 of the Ohio Revised Code to be contributed by the Superintendent and Administrators to STRS Ohio. The Celina City Board of Education is permitted to pick up employee contributions pursuant to Sections 3307.27 of the Ohio revised code and Section 414(h)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code. These picked up contributions, although designated as employee contributions, are being paid by the Celina City Board of Education in lieu of employee contributions and shall be paid by the board as a fringe benefit in addition to the contract salary otherwise payable to the employee. These contributions shall be treated as additional compensation and included in the salary for retirement purposes.

Employees in this group may not opt-out of the "picked up" contributions or elect to receive the contributed amounts directly instead of having them picked up by the Celina City Board of Education and paid to STRS Ohio.

Adoption of Pickup for classified school employees (except Administrators)

Be it resolved, effective July 1, 2006, the Celina City Board of Education agrees to "pick up" the total amount of employee contributions required by Ohio Revised Code section 3309 to be contributed by the school employees (all employees except Treasurer, Business Manager and other administrative staff) to SERS of Ohio. The Celina City Board of Education is permitted to pick up employee contributions pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Sections 3309 and Section 414(h) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code. These picked up contributions, although designated as employee contributions, are being paid by the Celina City Board of Education in lieu of employee contributions and shall be treated as a mandatory salary reduction from the contract salary otherwise payable to the employee.

Employees in this group may not opt-out of the "picked up" contributions or elect to receive the contributed amounts directly instead of having them picked up by the Celina City Board of Education and paid to SERS Ohio.

Adoption of Pickup for Treasurer, Business manager and other Classified Administrators Be it resolved, effective August 1, 2006, the Celina City Board of Education agrees to "pick up" the total amount of employee contributions required by Section 3309 of the Ohio Revised Code to be contributed by the Treasurer, Business manager and other administrative staff to

SERS of Ohio. The Celina City Board of Education is permitted to pick up employee contributions pursuant to Sections 3309 of the Ohio Revised Code and Section 414(h) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code. These picked up contributions, although designated as employee contributions, are being paid by the Celina City Board of Education in lieu of employee contributions and shall be paid by the board as a fringe benefit in addition to the contract salary otherwise payable to the employee. These contributions shall be treated as additional compensation and included in the salary for retirement purposes.

Employees in this group may not opt-out of the "picked up" contributions or elect to receive the contributed amounts directly instead of having them picked up by the Celina City Board of Education and paid to SERS Ohio.
