NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the Celina School District, Mercer County, Ohio, with at least two-thirds of its members concurring, that:

<u>Section 1</u>: The Board hereby declares the necessity of transferring the unexpended balance of the I.W. Pogue Scholarship Fund (007-9161) to the Education Foundation Fund (029-9100), in accordance with O.R.C. §5705.16, so as to permit the Board to continue using such funds for scholarship purposes.

<u>Section 2</u>: The Board hereby directs the Treasurer to petition the Ohio Tax Commissioner on the Board's behalf for approval of the transfer of the unexpended balance of the I.W. Pogue Scholarship Fund (007-9161) to the Education Foundation Fund (029-9100), in accordance with O.R.C. §5705.16.

<u>Section 3</u>: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public and in compliance with all legal requirements, including O.R.C. §121.22.
