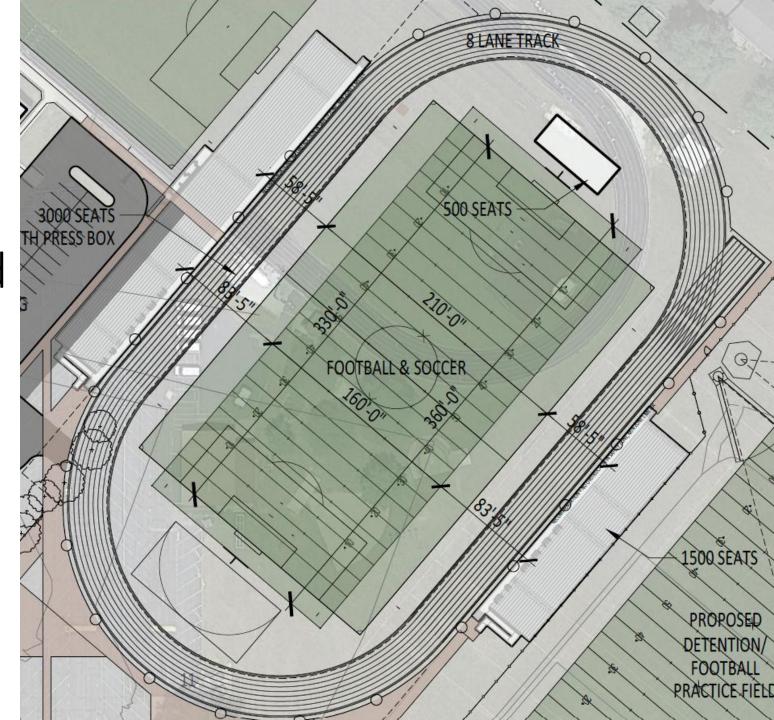




Football and Soccer in Track

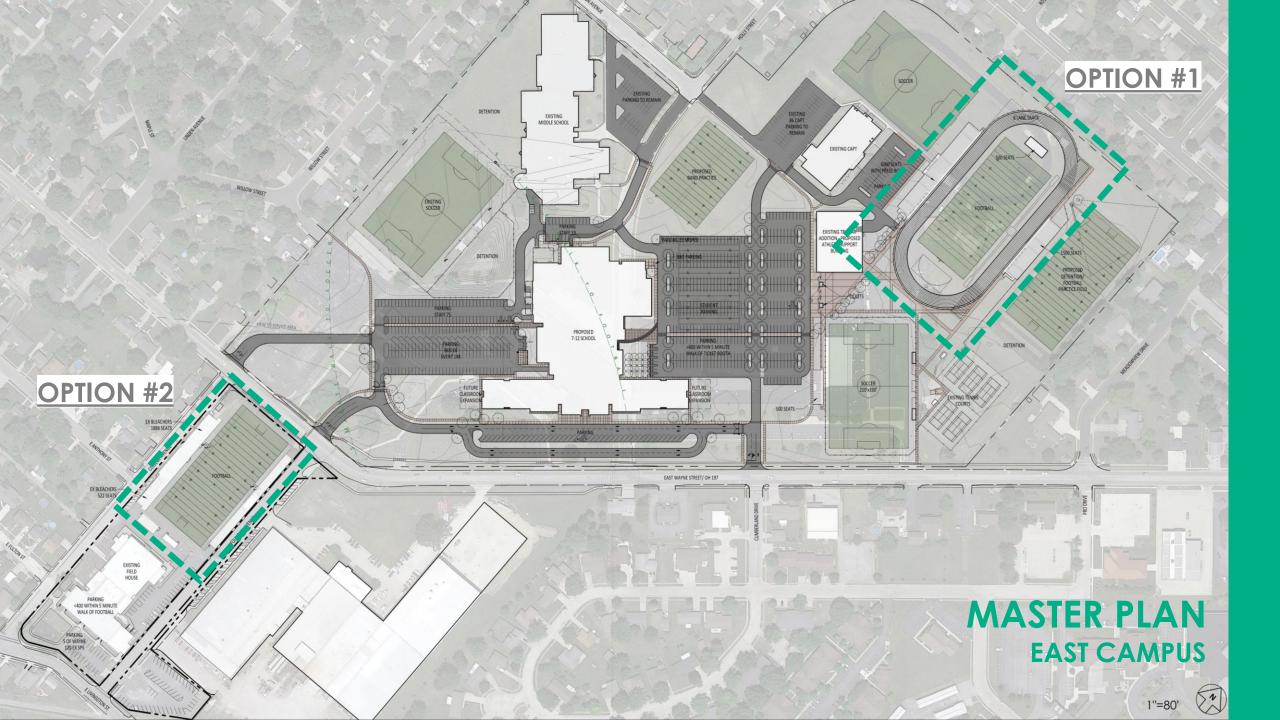
