As we move forward with e-days/blizzard bags, we are encouraging students to complete work online if able. To help with this option, students may sign out their assigned iPad from school. Student iPad's will be available for pick-up from 7am-7pm on Tuesday, April 7th. If student's do not have internet in the home, the iPad will not help with online learning. So, we will also have paper copies available for students. These paper copies will be available for pick-up from 7am-7pm on Tuesday, April 7th.

Celina Intermediate School will be open for essential business on Tuesday, April 7th from 7am-7pm. This essential business will include:

- Pick up Paper Copies of Work
- Drop off any finished work assigned for March 17-April 3
