

Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding is entered into on this ___ day of January, 2023, by and between Celina City School District Board of Education (“Board”) and the Celina Education Association (“Association”).

Whereas the Board and Association are parties to a Master Agreement effective from September 1, 2022 through August 31, 2024; and

Whereas the parties desire and intend through this Memorandum of Understanding to amend the Master Agreement,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PARTIES AGREE:

CELINA CITY SCHOOLS COLLEGE CREDIT PLUS (“CC+”) PROGRAM

Objective:

The purpose of the CC+ program is to provide opportunities for students to earn college credit and high school credit from courses they take at Celina City Schools. The goal is to have a selection of teachers and a selection of courses which are able to be taught at Celina City Schools, by teachers who are approved by Celina City Schools and are also approved as a professor for the college with which we are partnered.

Program Requirements:

- Teacher candidates must submit a letter of interest to their building principal to be considered for the program and be recommended by the building principal. Acceptance will be based on teacher evaluations, district needs, and recommendations from building principals.
- Once a teacher is approved to teach College Credit Plus (“CC+”) at Celina City Schools by both the Board and the college partner, he/she will receive a stipend of \$1,000 for the first class per semester taught. For each additional course per semester taught, he/she will receive a stipend of \$500 for teaching the same class an additional class period. If the additional CC+ class is a different course, then the teacher will receive an additional \$1,000 for teaching that additional CC+ class per semester. These stipends will be paid after the student school year, and before June 30.

- Approved teachers must attend professional development regarding instructional methods and curriculum materials. The Curriculum Director and Building Principal will design a professional development program with the input of the approved teacher.
- This MOU will expire on August 31, 2024.
