

RESOLUTION IMPLEMENTING A REDUCTION IN FORCE
OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE STAFF

The Board of Education of the Celina City School District, Mercer County, Ohio, met in regular session on the ____ day of _____ 2024, with the following members present:

The Treasurer advised the Board that the notice requirement of R.C. 121.22 and any amendments and implementing rules adopted by the Board pursuant thereto were complied with for the meeting.

WHEREAS, R.C. 3319.171 and Board Policy 1540 provide that the Board may reduce administrative staff in the District for certain reasons; and

WHEREAS, the Superintendent has recommended that the Board reduce an administrative staff member pursuant to R.C. 3319.171 and Board Policy 1540 due to the reorganization and consolidation of District administrative staff.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Education of the Celina City School District, Mercer County, Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Curriculum Director shall be reduced, effective August 1, 2025, due to the reorganization and consolidation of District administrative staff.

Section 2: Vaughn Ray will be laid-off and his/her administrative contract suspended, effective August 1, 2025, as a result of the implementation of the reduction in force.

Section 3: The Treasurer is hereby directed to furnish the aforementioned employee with written notice of the layoff.

Section 4: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and of any of its committees that resulted in these formal actions were in meetings open to the public and in compliance with all legal requirements, including R.C. 121.22 and any amendments thereto.
