My son Jarrett Payne is an exceptional swimmer. By exceptional, I mean number one in the nation for his age. He is so gifted, he has done something very rare. As a seventh grader, and 12 year old male, he has qualified for YMCA Nationals. At this meet, held in Greensboro, NC the first week of April, he will be competing against the very best high school swimmers in the nation. Although he has already received national recognition through various swim publications, this meet will most likely be the springboard for future US Junior National Team training camp invitations, Olympic Trial goals, and beyond. He has already broken seven YMCA National Age Group Records (age 11-12) this season, proving his ability and also the need to swim against high level competitors such as those found at this Short Course YMCA Nationals event.

In anticipation of his possible qualification for this meet, I have not used my three personal days this school year. If granted this request I will need two additional days (April 4th & 5th), for a total of 5 days absent - two of which will be Deduct Days. I have also secured a commitment from substitute Riley Luebke for my five day absence. Riley recently worked with me daily during a long-term substitute position he held in my building. I am comfortable and confident in his ability to keep things going in my absence.
