Celina City Schools Face Covering Plan

Students: Face Coverings are recommended (Not required). The face coverings may be a face mask or a face shield. Face coverings must be school appropriate in accords to the Student/Parent Handbook. Face coverings for students is a family decision.

Staff: Face Coverings are required (The face coverings may be a face mask or a face shield.), unless it is unsafe to do so or where doing so would significantly interfere with the learning process. Exceptions include:

- 1. Facial coverings are prohibited by law or regulation.
- 2. Facial coverings are in violation of documented industry standards.
- 3. Facial coverings are not advisable for health reasons. (Which includes working in a hot building which is not air-conditioned.)
- 4. Facial coverings are in violation of the school's documented safety policies.
- 5. Facial coverings are not required when the staff works alone in an assigned work area, or when the staff is more than six feet from students, such as when standing at the front of the classroom.
- 6. There is a functional(practical) reason for a staff member or volunteer to not wear a facial covering in the school building.

Visitors: Are generally discouraged from being in school district facilities. If visitors are in district facilities, they are required to wear a face covering.

Students, staff and volunteers who show symptoms of COVID-19 will be given a mask and wait in a space separate from the nurse's office or other areas where students are likely to visit.

Busses: Face coverings are recommended for students.
