1. Pure tone/acuity screening on every child at 1000Hz, 2000Hz and 4000Hz at 20 dB in both ears.

Hearing Screen Policy

- 2. If child responds at this level they pass with no further follow up.
- 3. If they fail pure tone a tympanogram will be completed immediately.
- 4. If both are failed immediate referral will be made.
- 5. If pass tymp but fail pure tone the child will be rescreened in approximately 4-6 weeks.6. If fail at rescreen then will be
