B. Treasurer Authorization:

- 4. Request advances on local taxes due to the school district from the County Auditor when funds are available.
- 5. Borrow money if needed for the general fund, along with the President.
- 6. Approve The People's Bank, First Financial Bank, Citizen's National Bank, Chase Bank, Fifth Third, Park National, and Caldwell Sutter as depositories for public funds.
- 7. Attend public records training as required to represent the Board of Education.

C. Superintendent Authorizations:

- 1. Appoint Superintendent and Treasurer as purchasing agents for the school district during CY 2024
- 2. Accept resignations between board meetings subject to ratification by the Board (to authorize the Superintendent, on behalf of this Board, to accept resignations which have been submitted by employees during times when this Board is not in session, subject to ratification by the Board; provided, however, that upon ratification by the Board, such resignations shall be deemed effective as of the date and time of the Superintendent's acceptance).

- 3. Hire employees between meetings subject to a subsequent vote of ratification by the Board (to authorize the Superintendent, during periods when this Board is not in session, to make offers of employment directly to candidates for either teaching or non-teaching positions on behalf of this Board, subject to subsequent vote of ratification by this Board; provided, however, that upon ratification by this Board, the employment shall be deemed effective as of the date and time of the employee's acceptance of the Superintendent's offer).
- 4. Submit applications for federal and state programs.
- 5. Appoint the Superintendent as the authorized representative to the Mercer-Auglaize Area Schools Employee Welfare Benefit Trust.

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- 1. Establish a Board Service Fund for the Celina Board of Education in the amount of \$7,500.00.
- 2. Set Board member compensation at \$80 per meeting for each individual for a maximum of eighteen (18) meetings per year; per Board Policy 0147.
- 3. Reaffirm that all board policies in effect on the date of this organizational meeting are continued in full force and in effect unless modified by subsequent action of the Board pursuant to ORC 3301-35-02.
