# CELINA CITY BOARD OF EDUCATION BOARD MINUTES MONDAY, JULY 10, 2023 ED COMPLEX AUDITORIUM 4:00 p.m.

The Celina City Board of Education met in regular session on July 10, 2023 at 4:00 p.m. in the Ed Complex Auditorium.
