## **12-15** <u>EXECUTIVE SESSION – O.R.C. §121.22(G)</u>

WHEREAS, as a public board of education may hold an executive session only after a majority of the quorum of this board determines by a roll call vote to hold such a session and only at a regular or special meeting for the sole purpose of the consideration of any of the following matters:

- (G)(1) To consider <u>one of more, as applicable</u>, of the following items with respect to a public employee or official:
  - 1. Appointment.
  - 2. \_\_\_Employment.
  - 3. Dismissal.
  - 4. Discipline.
  - 5. Promotion.
  - 6. \_\_\_\_Demotion.
  - 7. <u>Compensation</u>.
  - 8. \_\_\_Investigation of charges/complaints (unless public hearing requested).
- (G)(2) To consider the purchase of property for the public purposes or for the sale of property at competitive bidding.
- (G)(3) Conferences with an attorney for the public body concerning disputes involving the public body that are the subject of pending or imminent court action.
- (G)(4) Preparing for, conducting, or reviewing negotiations or bargaining sessions with public employees concerning their compensation or other terms and conditions of their employment.
- (G)(5) Matters required to be kept confidential by federal law or rules or state statutes.
- (G)(6) Specialized details of security arrangements where disclosure of the matters discussed might reveal information that could be used for the purpose of committing or avoid prosecution for a violation of the law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Celina City School District Board of Education, by a majority of the quorum present at this meeting, does hereby declare its intention to hold an executive session on item(G)(1) 2 listed above.

And the roll being called on its adoption, the vote resulted as follows:
