PREVIOUS PLAN: FINANCIAL SUMMARY



- Celina City Schools rank: 340
- Local share 56%, state share 44% of the co-funded scope
 - Celina contribution \$69,246,475 total (\$44,432,521 co-funded portion, \$24,813,954 in LFI)
 - State contribution \$34,911,266
- Property tax
 - 7.4 mills for maximum 38 years
 - 0.5 mill for 23 years for maintenance of facilities
 - 3 mills coming off the books in 2020

PREVIOUS PLAN: FINANCIAL SUMMARY



- 7.9 mills on a \$100,000 home is \$276.50 per year
- After the 3.0 mills, 4.9 mills on a \$100,000 home is \$184.62 per year







UPDATED MASTER PLAN

- Enrollment has increased
- OFCC budget costs have increased
- Equity rank changed:

329 in 2020 = 54% local share

309 in 2021 = 51% local share

TIMING OF OFCC MASTER PLAN APPROVAL



PROJECTED COST SET TO BE USED

- January 2021 11% increase (2020 OFCC cost set)
- April 2021 5% anticipated increase (2021 OFCC cost set)

LOCAL SHARE PERCENTAGE

- 56% previous local share March 2020 bond issue
- 54% current local share, effective January 2021
- 51% anticipated local share, effective July 2021





OFCC PROGRAM OPTIONS

- CLASSROOM FACILITIES ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (CFAP)
 - Program of previous bond campaign
 - Potential funding within two years
 - Option for a segmented program
- EXPEDITED LOCAL PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM (ELPP)
 - Outside of two-year window for state funding
 - Does require OFCC approval

 - State co-funded
- Segmented (phased) Master Plan project
 - Intermediate School renovation and addition PK-6
 - Abatement and demolition:
 - Primary School
 - Elementary School
 - State co-funded
- Delay any facilities project



FULL MASTER PLAN PROJECT - 54% local share

- \$78.6 million (\$22.8 million in LFI)
- 37-year bond
- 7.5 mills
- \$255 per year on \$100,000 home





SEGMENTED MASTER PLAN PROJECT - 54% local share

Only PK-6; future bond for high school, junior high

- \$31.5 million (\$9.1 million in LFI)
- 37-year bond
- 2.99 mills
- \$105 per year on \$100,000 home





FULL MASTER PLAN PROJECT - 51% local share

- \$75.6 million (\$22.8 million in LFI)
- 37-year bond
- 7.5 mills
- \$245 per year on \$100,000 home





SEGMENTED MASTER PLAN PROJECT - 51% local share

Only PK-6; future bond for high school, junior high

- \$30 million (\$9.1 million in LFI)
- 37-year bond
- 2.89 mills
- \$100 per year on \$100,000 home
