

Reading Requirements

Welcome to reading class!!!! Our main focus this year is to increase your skills in vocabulary, reading, comprehension, and to encourage you to achieve at your highest possible level.

KEYS TO SUCCESS IN READING:

1. Come prepared (binder, pencil, assignments, and any other requested items)
2. Use class time wisely
3. **ALWAYS** have an AR book with you
4. Please take assigned seat and be ready to begin class within 3 minutes
5. Follow classroom courtesies posted in my classroom

HOMEWORK POLICY:

1. Assignments need to be complete for the assigned day. Assignments are due at the *beginning* of the period that you have reading class. Assignments turned in after that point would be considered late. A green slip will be earned for assignments not turned in on time.
2. A percentage will be deducted for assignments turned in within *One* school day after the assignment is due.

GRADING:

The points earned from major projects (50%)

Quizzes and mini-projects (30%)

Notebook organization and homework (20%)

CLASS BINDER:

You will be required to keep a binder documenting your work. Students will periodically be given binder checks, which will check organization and completeness of the work given in class. A sample binder will be available throughout the nine weeks. Students are responsible to ask where papers are to be located when they return from an absence. The binder ends up being a great reference tool for locating literature information and studying for tests. Parents may use this as a tool to check student's progress on test, quizzes, and major assignments in addition to Progress Book.

ACCELERATED READER:

Each student will be given an AR goal. This AR goal may be adjusted higher or lower depending on the student's abilities. Taking computer generated test will be required upon completion of books.
